Position: Wolf Educator Intern - Academic

Location: International Wolf Center, Ely, Minnesota

Duration: August 5, 2021 – August 26, 2022 (dates may be somewhat flexible to accommodate academic calendars and programming needs)

Hours: 40+ hours per week including work on evenings, weekends, and holidays
