



# Wolf Educator Internship

**Position:** Wolf Educator Intern – Year-long term

**Location:** International Wolf Center, Ely, Minnesota

**Duration:** August 1, 2024– August 25, 2025 (dates may be somewhat flexible to accommodate academic calendars and programming needs)

**Hours:** 40+ hours per week including work on evenings, weekends, and holidays

**Stipend:** \$2,000 per month (does not include housing)

## **Responsibilities:**

- Conduct wolf education and natural history programs for the public and groups
- Teach large and small groups as well as answer wolf and natural history questions from visitors
- Lead interpretive hikes and field trips
- Assist in program development for people of all ages
- Respond to wolf information inquiries by phone and e-mail
- Create projects for the education department as assigned
- Other duties as assigned
- *Please note: Due to the nature of our socialized pack, interns do not have direct contact with ambassador wolves.*
